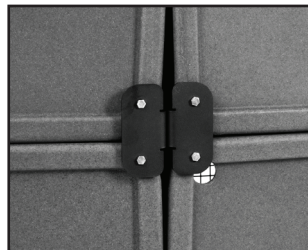

When connecting only two kennels, you will not use the "back side" of the brackets.

Two Kennels:

1. Stack two kennels in the desired configuration.
2. Place and hold bracket where you will connect the kennels and mark hole locations for drilling.
3. Drill a 1/4" hole in marked locations on each kennel.
4. Attach bracket to first kennel with a bolt, washer, and nut.
5. Line up the bracket and second kennel and attach the other end of the bracket to the second kennel.
6. Repeat process on the other side of the kennels.
7. For additional stability, repeat process on the back side of the kennels (you will need an additional stacking kit).



When connecting four kennels, you will need at least two kennel stacking kits.

Four Kennels:

1. Connect two of the brackets "back-to-back" with a bolt, washer, and nut through the single hole.
2. Stack four kennels in the desired configuration and insert the connected part of the bracket between the four kennels.
3. Place and hold brackets where you will connect the kennels and mark hole locations for drilling.
4. Drill a 1/4" hole in each kennel in the marked locations.
5. Attach connected brackets to first kennel with a bolt, washer, and nut.
6. Line up the connected brackets with each subsequent kennel and attach each end of the brackets to kennels.
7. Follow the instructions for two kennels to connect the outside corners with the remaining two brackets.
8. For additional stability, repeat process on the back side of the kennels (you will need an additional two stacking kits).
